Winslow Indian Health Care Center Rolls Out First COVID-19 Mass Vaccine Clinic in Jeddito, Arizona



WINSLOW, Ariz. — On Tuesday, Winslow Indian Health Care Center (WIHCC), in collaboration with Navajo Nation Community Health Representatives, Navajo Nation Health Education, Navajo County Sheriff's Department, Jeddito Chapter House and Jeddito Senior Center, scheduled 61 appointments for the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine. With no wait time, a total of 42 WIHCC patients received their Moderna vaccine.

Rodger Paul, Jeddito Chapter President, thanked WIHCC for their continued support amid COVID-19 by administering COVID-19 vaccines with a drive-thru vaccine clinic. "I would like to extend my appreciation for what WIHCC is doing for the rural community of Jeddito. We have been facing COVID-19 for almost a year; We have lost many of the community members and relatives. We have been encouraging our community members to follow all CDC guidelines to protect themselves and one another. Ahe'hee WIHCC for bringing the vaccine to our people to beat COVID-19," says Rodger Paul, who also serves on the WIHCC Board of Directors.
