Winslow Indian Health Care Center Drive-thru COVID-19 Community Outreach Vaccination Clinic in Birdsprings, Arizona



BIRDSPRINGS, Ariz. — On Thursday, Winslow Indian Health Care Center (WIHCC), in collaboration with Navajo Nation Community Health Representatives, Navajo Nation Health Education Program and Navajo County Sheriff's Department, scheduled 46 appointments for the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine. With no wait time, a total of 35 WIHCC patients received their one and only dose of Johnson & Johnson Vaccine at the Birdsprings Chapter House. WIHCC is exemplifying what can be accomplished by listening to our public health experts and working together as a team. Let's reach Community Immunity!

The COVID-19 vaccines are **safe and effective** and it is recommended you get a COVID-19 vaccine as soon as it's available to you (Safety of COVID-19 Vaccines, 2021). The most common side effects are pain, redness and/or swelling in the arm where you received the shot. You may also experience other common side effects such as: Tiredness, headache, muscle pain, chills, fever and/or nausea. These side effects usually start within a day or two of getting the vaccine. Side effects might affect your ability to do daily activities, but they should go away in a few days. WIHCC encourages everyone to continue to wear

a mask, stay at least 6 feet apart, avoid crowds & poorly ventilated spaces, wash hands often and get a vaccine when it's available to you.


