COVID-19 Surge Prompts WIHCC Services Back to Drive-Thru Set Up

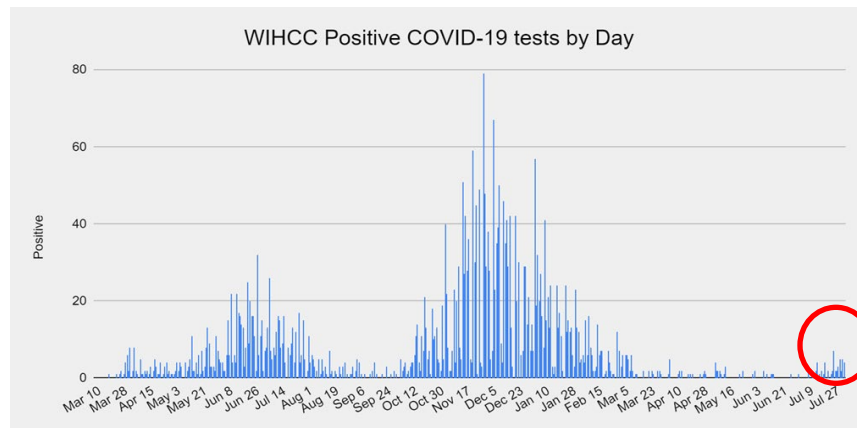


Figure 1. Most recent update on the surge of WIHCC service area.

WINSLOW, Ariz. — Due to the increase in positive COVID-19 numbers and the arise of the new delta variant across the nation, Winslow Indian Health Care Center will reinstate the drive-thru system of two car lanes for COVID testing and for COVID vaccinations starting on **Monday August 16, 2021**. Vaccines will no longer be given inside the Medical Office Building (MOB) Conference room and will be moved to the outside drive-thru. Signage and employees at outside blue booths will help direct all patients.

Leupp clinic will close its services on Monday August 16, 2021 and will remain closed for the immediate future. All patients with appointments at Leupp clinic will be contacted and informed that their visit will be converted to a telephone visit. Dilkon clinic will also remain closed until further notice.
